Dear Year 8 Parent/Carer/Student,

As you will have learned from Mr White's recent message, we have had confirmation of a positive Covid case and we have had to send a number of students home to self-isolate until 1st December.

Students who are required to self-isolate must not come to school until Tuesday 1st December and should not leave home during that time. Other family members may follow normal national restrictions, unless someone in the household develops symptom. If this happened the whole household must self-isolate. If an isolating student takes a Covid test that is positive then please inform the school immediately and follow track and trace guidance. If a test is taken that returns as negative, the period of self-isolation **must continue until 1st December**, the end of the infection window.

For those students who are not self-isolating, lessons in school will continue as normal. Please attend school if you are well.

For those who have to self-isolate in 8B and 8R, our online provision will be provided in a "live" format. The class teacher will be present in the class Microsoft Team during the hour of the lesson and will deliver the lesson through either direct presentation, or setting or work and being able to answer questions or provide support as this is done.

We expect self-isolating children to be online in the Microsoft Teams environment and to have their Team for the subject open at the normal time of the lesson, to see the work set and to be available: to listen the teacher if the lesson can be taught live; or to get on with independent work that the teacher will monitor as they do it.

We would like to thank you for your co-operation and to be patient with staff if technical problems arise, we are all (students and staff) on a very steep learning curve with online education. We also recognise learning on line is hard for students too and we will only expect everyone to do the best they can in challenging circumstances.
