Dear Parent/Carer,

As you will know, we have asked students to come to school in their PE kit on the days that they have PE. This is so we can avoid using the school changing rooms as a response to Covid-19. Thank you for your support in this.

Whilst the weather has been warm, students have often preferred to come to school in shorts and skorts. Now that the weather is turning colder, we are asking students to come to school in clothing more suited to the colder months.

Please could we ask you to ensure the following:

- If students choose to wear shorts, they are encouraged to wear plain black jogging bottoms (no logo) over the top of the shorts. This will ensure that they are able to change quickly for their PE lesson. It is not acceptable for students to wear their jogging bottoms in PE lessons
- If students choose to wear skorts, they are asked to wear either plain black or Leventhorpe leggings (available from our uniform suppliers) under their skorts in preparation for PE lessons. Students may also wear plain black jogging bottoms (no logo) over the top of their skorts but these must be removed for PE lessons

May we also take the opportunity to ask you to check to ensure that skorts are of an appropriate size and length. On occasions, students are coming to school wearing skorts that are too small and that are therefore inappropriate for school use.
